



## What is Friends In Need Health Center, Inc.?

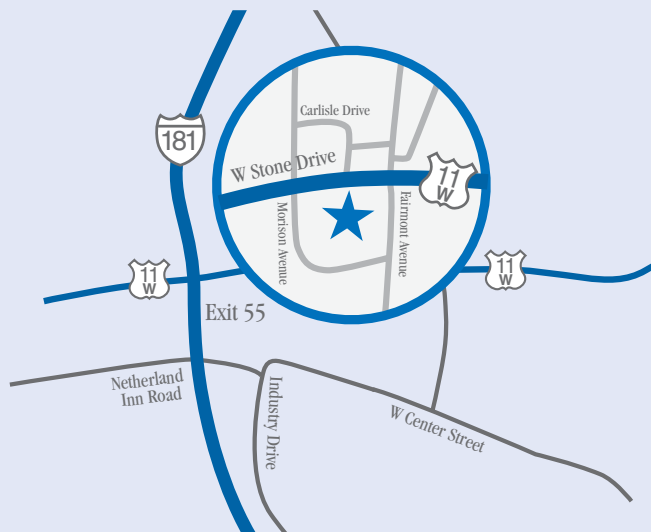
Friends In Need Health Center is a regionally supported clinic that offers quality and affordable care to the working uninsured.

- Patients who live in Hawkins, Scott or Sullivan counties.
- Patients who have a job or have a member of the household who has a job but do not have insurance.
- Patients who are not receiving any other help with medical care such as TennCare, Medicare, Virginia Medicaid, Social Security Disability or Health/Supplemental Insurance

## How can you become a patient?

1. Call Friends In Need Health Center at 423/246-0010
2. Make an appointment to talk with the office staff about how Friends In Need can help you.
3. Bring the following information when you come to your appointment:

**Picture identification (such as a driver's license)**

**Recent telephone or electric bill with your name and address on it**

**Social security cards for all your household members**

**Last two pay stubs for all income earners in your household**

**Copy of last year's income tax return**

**Recent bank statement, if available**

**Letters from any government agencies such as TennCare or the Department of Human Services**

## How much does it cost?

Patients will be charged a percentage of the actual fee based on total family income and the number of members in the household.
